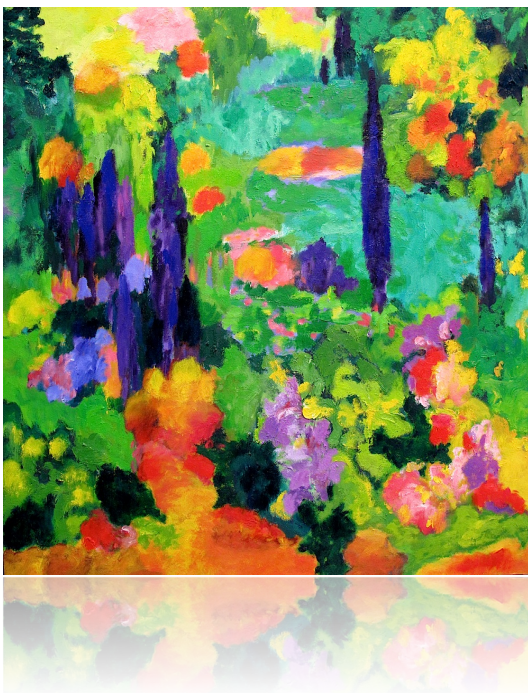
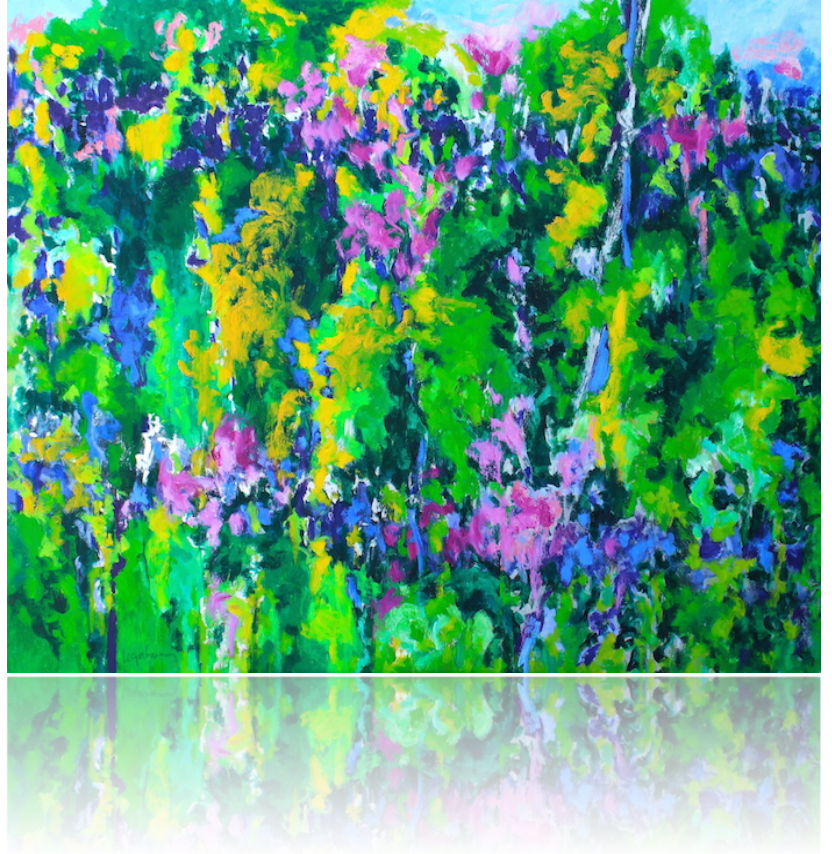


José Antonio Legorburu

José Antonio Legorburu was born in Zarautz (Spain) in 1952. He studied technical architecture and interior design in Burgos.

In 1967 he won the first prize for Guipuzcoan oil painting. He later afterwards he obtained several prizes in the Euskadi outdoor painting competition

In 1980 he had his first solo exhibition in Zarautz, He participated in the IV Bienal Contemporary painting in Barcelona and he ended the year with a solo exhibition in the Cultural Center of Palencia



In 1983 he exhibited in the San Telmo Museum of Donostia, had a solo exhibition in the Arts Centre of Onuna in La Laguna (Tenerife) and he was selected by the Culture Department of the Basque government for the itinerant exhibition "Ertibil" 83 y 84.

He alternated his exhibitions and creations with teaching oil painting in Artezaleak. In 2008 he organized "Coloquio de tubos". Legorburu incorporated in his paintings a new visión of the landscape. He applies in his painting ones composite and structured rhythms where the volume-outline is defined in only one spectrum, splashed with complementary tones of agile and thick brush-strokes.
